Minutes of meeting on Tuesday, 26th June 2018.

Reports:

Ralph presented his report for the maintenance carried out by him and Margie during the month of June. Besides general maintenance, he and Margie directed a lot of their efforts on removing clumps of grass and weeds from the trail. There is much more grass to remove. He reported that the Cross Island Trail is generally in good shape. Ralph noted that the CVRD contract mowing has recently been completed.

With many hands, on June 10, in Boyle Point Park, the second trail sign was repositioned and secured. The trail was brushed between the second and third trail signs. Because of the very efficient crew, clearing continued beyond the third sign.

Tim and Graeme reported for the Parks Committee that no meeting was held in June. However, Graeme reported that the work has commenced on the Chickadee Lake trail by BC Parks. The trail which will connect Lake Road to the east side of Chickadee Lake will be built by a BC Parks crew starting on July 9. A walking trail will be constructed this summer, with a multipurpose trail hopefully following in the fall.

Old Business:

The erection of the sign in Boyle Point Park in the vicinity of the rocky outcrop needs to be scheduled. Methods of securing this sign in an appropriate location were discussed.

New Business:

Wednesday, 10th July is the date for our next trail clearing; we will be clearing trails connecting to the Railway Grade Marsh trail. We will meet on Northwest Road at the Butterfly project area entrance at 9-am. The work will involve brush cutting and minor chain saw work, fire danger rating permitting.
