2. <u>Sailing Club Insurance Query:</u>

A representative from the Denman Sailing Club approached DIRA to find out if it is possible to get less expensive insurance coverage if they are a committee of DIRA instead of an independent not-for-profit society. They do not want DIRA to pay for the insurance. The Sailing Club started in 2014/15 with 6 donated lasers and is currently getting "event" insurance coverage for the 2 or 3 week period sailing lessons are provided at a cost of about \$650. They want to be able to provide sailing from May through September but have been quoted over \$3,000 for this insurance coverage.

Ron will contact the DIRA insurance underwriter to investigate if less expensive insurance options are available.

Ron will also contact the Hornby Residents and Ratepayers Association to investigate the insurance coverage which is provided to their Sailing Club. The Sailing Association will provide Ron will more details regarding specific activities as required.

- 4. <u>Bottle Depot Internet and Other Proposed Service Costs:</u> Bob advised the board that ENCORP wants the Bottle Depot to start using their electronic computer tabulation system (POR Point of Return). The cost is about \$900 annually to be part of the ENCORP service contract plus an annual cost of about \$1,500 for other costs such as telephone, WIFI and other. Productivity savings may be realized locally. The concern is with regard to the increased cost which the Bottle Depot manager is responsible for approving or not approving.
- 5. <u>Insurance Renewal Update Regarding Additional Named Insured Party for Bottle Depot Electronic Recycling Initiative:</u> ENCORP has been added to the DIRA insurance policy with no additional cost.
