2. Ferry Advisory Committee

The last BC Ferries Advisory meeting was via web-ex with 2 ferries reps with Hornby reps and the following Denman reps; Chris Danks, Rob Manering, Kevin Hutton, Sam Borthwick and Laura Thorlacius.

The Ferry Advisory Committee gave BC Ferries a list of priority demands. Denman and Hornby agree on the need to replace the Baynes Sound Connector and tandem sailings (2 boats) in Buckley Bay for 10 months and 7 days per week. Hornby wants up to half the deck space on all sailing reserved for Hornby. Denman does not agree with this item.

There may be a community engagement meeting on July 5th.

There is also some discussion with BC Ferries to get some funding for the dock since it is used for emergencies and for their crew changes when needed. The water taxi, used for emergency evacuations does not pay for the use of the dock.
