#### **Executive Report:**

1. Announcement of Community Recreation Grant Recommendations from DIRA to CVRD– Moira Webster Report can be viewed at <u>www.denmanresidents.com</u>

**Motion:** That the recommendations made on July 12, 2010, by the DIRA Recreation Grant Committee awarding Denman Seniors & Museum Society \$10,000; Denman Community Education Society, \$8,000; the Swim Dock Committee, \$750; the Community Dock Committee, \$750; and the Denman/Hornby Equine Association, \$500; for a total of \$20,000 be accepted and forwarded to the Comox Valley Regional District for approval. M/S/*carried* 

2. Membership announcement: The Chair advised that anyone who has not paid their membership dues as of today will be removed from membership list but will be able to return as a new member. The membership committee is disbanded due to the changes in the Constitution and the more efficient use of the Website. Minutes and Agendas will no longer be sent out each month via e-mail but can be accessed at www.denmanresidents.com. Committee Chairs are requested to send their reports to the Secretary via e-mail to ensure the reports are included on the website with the minutes.

### **Liaison Reports:**

- 1. VIRL: Bill Engleson The facilities report that VIRL was doing has been submitted. A meeting with Bruce Jolliffe has resulted in some strategies moving forward and Bruce will ensure that Denman receives a copy of the VIRL report hope to have more news in September.
- 2. **Ferry Advisory:** Dennis Forsyth –reported that a Ferry Advisory Committee meeting on July 7<sup>th</sup> at the Seniors Hall. Gordon Nettle, Marine Superintendent, Northern Island, gave the operations report which included:
  - The service appears efficient runs on time and as it should
  - Noted some concern regarding off-loading procedures seems to be random fashion assures it will be looked into and dealt with
  - BCFerries policy is to discourage shuttling during lunch hour as this practice results in overtime costs.
  - BCFerries new policy regarding unattended packages on ferries current practice must cease.
  - BCFerries proposing phase-out of printed comprehensive schedule as it is available on-line. Route specific is still fine.
  - Anticipate the Kaloki season will be extended for longer periods of time (Denman/Hornby)
  - BCFerries is pursuing the cable ferry alternative vigorously suggests a possibility that it will be in operation in 3 years. However, Mark Stephenson, Vice President of Public Affairs stated he felt the possibility of cable ferry on route 21 was a 50/50 toss-up of getting it. Serious negotiations with First Nations on Vancouver Island taking place issue not clarified.
  - BCFerries do commit, and have committed to, one more public meeting on Denman Island will schedule for evening session before they commence any implementation of cable ferry. The meeting will be Informational not a consultation.
  - BCFerries wants to move to an annual (ferry advisory) meeting rather than semi-annual.
  - Next meeting either in October or November will likely be on Hornby Island

- Karl Goodwin objects to the Coca-Cola ads on the Ferry tickets and Dennis will take this issue to the next meeting.
- At the next DIRA meeting Dennis would like to discuss the issue of conflict of interest as he acts as a representative for DI and is also a major organizer for the Readers and Writers festival which receives funding from BC Ferries

## **Committee Reports:**

 DICEEC Community Project Grant Announcement – Sharon Clarke – Full report can be viewed at <u>www.denmanresidents.com</u> Provided a report outlining the process and panel members along with project recommendations. Arts Denman, \$9,310; Denman Island Community Education Society, \$1,400; Denman Island Seniors & Museum Society, \$8,750; Hornby Denman Tourism Services, \$3,400. Total funding recommendation is \$22,940. DICEEC voted to carry forward the remaining funds \$15,060 to a second round of funding in early 2011. The recommendations will be delivered to the CVRD for their approval and disbursement of funds. The Committee will now prepare for the budget submission in September and invites the community to attend July 26, 2010 from 3 – 6 p.m. for an opportunity to provide the committee with their input.

Motion : To accept the DICEEC Community Projects Funding Recommendations Report. M/S/carried

2. DIVFD- Chief Luckett – Thanked the community for their support at the pancake breakfast and reported that the effort netted in excess of \$4,000. Dock committee raised \$700 at the pancake breakfast. DIMS raised \$400. At midnight on Thursday July 8 a fire ban was brought into effect – campfire ban on Monday 19<sup>th</sup>. DIVFD will be hosting the Comox Valley Fire Chief's Association meeting on Monday July 19, 2010. Letters of commendation were received for 4 First Responders, related to an incident on East Rd., to Rob Manering, Jeremy Cartier, Richard Green, and Vali Majd. A new member of auxiliary brings it to the maximum of 10. A new member for fire department in two weeks will bring the roster to a maximum however applications will be received for a waiting list.

The Chief will send an official letter to Emcon addressing residents' concern regarding the fire hazard of the long grass along road sides. Residents also expressed concern for children and animal safety as well due to the extremely long grass.

Action: The DIRA Chair offered to send a letter from the membership as well, with a copy to the Ministry of Transportation (attention Sue Pauwels).

- 3. **Dock Committee:** John Johnston reported that the committee raised just under \$700 at the DIVFD's pancake breakfast selling tickets for the raffle and thanked the Fire Department. He also advised that the committee has split 12 cords of wood with only 3 cords remaining (all three cords sold before the end of his report). Updated the members on the status of funding applications and noted that John Duncan's office is helpful in insuring a fair hearing. The project will be depending heavily on community involvement. Will make announcements on the funding status in August in the Grapevine and the Flagstone papers. Anticipate lining up tendering and volunteers by December for start in June 2011.

May it be resolved that the following language be added to the DIRA funding application policy: if the Executive of DIRA sub-committee must respond rapidly to a request for applications from a funding body in order for DIRA to be considered for funds, the Chairperson may authorize the specifically responsible Executive member or committee chairperson to apply to such funding agency and the Chairperson will report to the Executive and the general membership at the next regular meeting.
