### 4. <u>Update on CVRD Parks:</u>

A contract has been awarded to a local person to repair the damaged stairs and beach access at Morning Beach Park.

# 5. <u>Update on Waste Management:</u>

A new class of plastic material is now being accepted at the recycling centre. An advertisement was in the Grapevine letting residents know about the change.

The recycling centre will not be open Saturday afternoon.

#### 6. Financial Report and Update on Budget Process:

Doug provided a financial update regarding the Union Bay Credit Union accounts as follows:

Letter of Credit: \$5,202

Long Term Account: \$16,805

The budget for next fiscal year is due in Nov and will be discussed in detail at the next general meeting.

Doug announced that he will resign as treasurer after many years. He will provide some help as required during the transition. Several residents thanked him for those many years of community service.

## 7. <u>Denman/Hornby Health Care Society:</u>

Bill Engleson made a presentation to generate some interest in getting Denman residents to serve on the board. He has served for 7 years now and there is a need for more Denman representation. Hornby has 4 board members and Denman soon will have only 2. The budget is over \$1.5 million per year which is mainly from Island Health.
