Denman Recycling accepts Packaging and Printed Paper according to Multi Material BC (MMBC) protocol, sorted into the following categories: (More details available at MMBC website: recyclinginbc.ca)

# **Printed Paper**

Newspapers, flyers, home/office paper, envelopes, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper gift wrap, greeting cards, shredded paper in clear bag.

**No** paper towels, napkins, books (ask attendant), padded envelopes, ribbons/bows, or musical cards.

# Cardboard (Paper Packaging)

Corrugated, boxboard, paper bags (any colour), egg cartons, paper pet food bags.

Please empty, remove box liners, & flatten.

No waxed cardboard, foil-lined bags/cardboard.

# **Cartons/Paper Cups**

Non-deposit gable-top cartons (e.g. milk), non-deposit 'tetrapaks' (e.g. milk, soup), coffee cups, microwavable bowls, ice cream cartons.

Please rinse well, remove caps, & flatten.

No straws, standup pouches.

# **Plastic Containers**

Bottles, jugs, jars, clamshells, tubs, drink cups, garden pots, pails less than 25 liters.

Please rinse well and remove lids/caps. Include lids/caps with plastic recycling.

**No** biodegradable plastic, paint containers, 'stand-up' pouches, foil-lined blister packs, bowls with metal rims (e.g. soup containers), plastic furniture, toys, kitchenware, hoses, plastic strapping and rope.

*Milk jugs, motor oil containers, and anti-freeze containers are collected in separate bags/bins - ask attendant.* 

# **Glass Bottles/Jars**

Non-deposit, clear or coloured.

Please rinse well, remove caps, & clean. Labels are okay. Recycle caps with metal.

# **Metal Containers**

Steel and aluminum cans, clean foil, empty aerosol cans that contained food or shaving cream, etc.

**No** aerosols that contained paint or toxics; must be empty.

Please rinse well, drop metal lid inside can, and squeeze top of tin.

# **`Styrofoam' Packaging**

Meat trays, egg cartons, molded cushion packaging for electronics, etc.

Please rinse well, remove and discard absorbent pad and stretch wrap.

Remove any tape, cardboard.

**No** squishy foam, insulation, cushions, or foam peanuts.

#### **Plastic Bags/Overwrap**

Clean, dry soft plastic bags for groceries, produce, bread, etc., overwrap for mattresses, paper products, (e.g. paper towels).

Bags **MUST** be empty, clean, and dry.

**No** stretch wrap, zipper-lock bags, chip/snack bags, garbage bags, 'crinkly' wrap, biodegradable plastic, shipping envelopes, lumber-wrap, multi-layer or laminated film, or any wrap for perishable foods (meat, cheese, fish) or with residue of original contents.

#### Other items accepted for recycling...

#### **Batteries**

Please separate into alkaline or 'regular', rechargeable (NiCd/NiMH, small lead acid), and Lithium or Lithium Ion (includes small button batteries). Leave car batteries beneath counter.

## Motor Oil/Antifreeze Containers

Please empty and leave caps on. Do not include with other plastics.

## Scrap Metal

Modest amounts of scrap steel, aluminum, copper, and brass.

Always see attendant for instructions. Please fold and tie fencing, lumber strapping, and wire.

**No** nails, small bits, wire, fencing or other tangly items in outside bin.

No large appliances or heavy items.

No access when Recycling Centre is closed.

#### **Propane Containers**

Propane containers must be empty.

#### Thermostats

See attendant for details.

#### Available for Re-use

Egg cartons in good shape | Magazines | Boxes | Bottles & Jars for canning, jam, storage, winemaking.

Accepted: Clean clothing, toys and household items in good condition.

A "between islanders" list is available for finding a home for larger items, along with Denman Island facebook bulletin boards.

Please see volunteers with donated goods.

*Please do not leave items outside, except reusable bikes, clean reusable garden pots.* 

# **Not accepted**: TVs, computers, microwaves, and furniture.

*Courtenay Return Centre, 493 Puntledge Road, Courtenay accepts electronics, small appliances, electric tools, light fixtures, light bulbs, and paint.*
